The place serves pizza, pasta, salads and subs, among other things, and is mostly famous for their specialty pizzas: Royal Feast, Farmers Almanac, King's Feast, Queen Feast and BBQ Bacon Double Cheeseburger Pizza. There are also buffalo wings starting at \$4.70, cheese fingers for \$3.75 and toasted cheeseburgers for \$1.65. Sir Pizza delivers after four and can be reached at 372-6909.

I actually wish it didn't catch so much attention; it's a little flashy."

Overall, the women interviewed valued size and style above anything else, but they were all proud of the prices they paid. Purses range in price from a couple of quarters to hundreds of thousands of dollars, like Hermes Kelly bags, averaging at \$5000 each (www.artnet.com), or Margaret Thatcher's handbag, which sold on eBay for £103,000, making it the most expensive UK item ever sold on the site (www.carpages.co.uk).
